### **Ride Cherriots to the Extreme Makeover Reveal**

September 13 is a big day for the Oregon School for the Deaf. The school was chosen as the site for the filming of an upcoming episode of the ABC reality show "Extreme Makeover Home Edition". The show's crew has been working around the clock to construct a new boys' dormitory and give the school's "Nightmare Factory" fundraiser a makeover.

Monday is the "Reveal Day" when the finished product will be unveiled. The public is welcome to come and see the amazing work that has taken place over the past week.

Parking will be limited at the event. The public is encouraged to ride Cherriots to the School for the Deaf on routes 9 and 19. You can also get to the school by parking in designated locations throughout the Salem Keizer area and using Cherriots service to connect to the site. The cost for the trip is \$3.25 for an unlimited use day-pass (\$1.50 for seniors or persons with disabilities). A single trip fare is \$1.50 for adults.

Directions from the park and ride lots are as follows:

At the State Fairgrounds, you can either catch the bus or a shuttle provided by Hut Airport Limousine. State Fairgrounds parking is on the south side of the Fairgrounds near the corner of 17th St. NE and Sunnyview Rd. NE. You can catch Cherriots route 20 at the corner of 17th St. NE and Sunnyview Rd. NE. Take route 20 to downtown and transfer to either route 9 River Rd./Park Meadow or 19 River Rd./Keizer Station to the stop at Broadway and Tryon Ave. Walk just under two blocks on Tryon to the school's visitor entrance to the site. Route 20 runs every 30 minutes from 6:00 am – 9:00 am and 2:00 pm – 7:00 pm, hourly between 9:00 am and 2:00 pm and ends at 7:00 pm. Routes 9 and 19 run every 15 minutes from 6:15 am to 9:00 pm.

Directions from I-5:

From Market St. exit 256 go one block west, turn right on Hawthorne and enter the park and ride on the left.

Catch route 17 Market St. at the stop located on the Market St. side of the park and ride lot. Take route 17 to downtown and transfer to either route 9 River Rd./Park Meadow or 19 River Rd./Keizer Station to the stop at Broadway and Tryon Ave. Walk just under

two blocks on Tryon to the school's visitor entrance to the site. All of these routes run every 15 minutes from 6:15 am to 9:00 pm.

From Hwy. 22 exit 253 go 0.6 miles west, turn right on Airport Rd., then turn right to the Airport Rd. park and ride. Catch route 16 State St. at the bus shelter. Take route 16 to downtown and transfer to either route 9 River Rd./Park Meadow or 19 River Rd./Keizer Station to the stop at Broadway and Tryon. Walk just under two blocks on Tryon to the school's visitor entrance to the site. Route 16 runs every 30 minutes and routes 9 and 19 run every 15 minutes from 6:15 am to 9:00 pm.
