**Subject:** Status of ITS Phase 4 RFP effort – Comprehensive CAD/AVL

In February 2019, SAMTD issued RFP 19-001 for acquisition of solutions as part of an Intelligent Transportation System (ITS). The RFP specifically requested that interested vendors provide a proposal for the delivery of several components of an Intelligent Transportation System solution, most commonly associated with Comprehensive CAD/AVL -

- Computer Aided Dispatch / Automatic Vehicle Location (CAD/AVL)
- Automatic Stop Announcements
- Automatic Passenger Counter
- Vehicle Communications System with covert alarm
- Real Time Passenger Information System
- Central System hosting
- Open fare payment systems (optional)
- Data Collection and Reporting tools / Business Intelligence (optional)

The selection committee, made up of representatives from Transportation Development, Maintenance, Operations, Customer Service, Technology Services and Procurement, met numerous times over the last several months to review responses, participate in product demonstrations and check references for each responding vendor. A summary of the vendors that responded to the RFP, and their status is found in Table 1 on the next page.

The last steps in the evaluation process are scheduled to occur June 3 through June 10, 2019; therefore, at the time of this memo, the final recommendation has not been determined. Should a selection be made as forecast, the committee will forward that selection to Procurement for the next phase of the process with the intent to bring

forth a recommendation to the Board for the June 27 Board meeting. Should the process take longer to complete than the intervening three weeks can accommodate, the recommendation will be brought to the Board at the July 25 Board meeting.

**Subject:** Contract Amendment Request for Keizer Transit Center Signalized

Intersection Construction Design Support Services

Kittleson and Associates, Inc. (KAI) have been providing design and construction support services for the Keizer Transit Center (KTC) Signalized Intersection project since the project began. KAI is now providing construction support for the project that is currently under construction. These services include clarification of existing design drawings, clarification of engineering calculations; and also, the creation of new drawings to address changes occasionally encountered during construction to address issues related to unforeseen circumstances. In most cases these adjustments are minor and of a minimal cost.

Early into the construction of the KTC Signalized Intersection project, it was discovered that utility locations were significantly different than where the as-built drawings indicated. One critical location was the location of electrical and cable conduits that were discovered to run directly in the path of the proposed retaining wall to be constructed as part of the project. This situation in particular presented challenging engineering and redesign of this part of the project; as well as others that are related to the alignment of sidewalks, curbs, storm-water collection, and other elements that had to be adjusted. As a result, additional design and engineering costs were incurred that, in total, will exceed the construction support portion of the project budget.

The proposed amendment will increase the project budget by \$46,000 which includes \$41,497 of estimated expenses and a 10.85% contingency (this percentage rounds the amount to an even \$46,000). The estimate was provided by KAI. The hourly rates did not change from the original contract, and the tasks and rates have been reviewed and verified as reasonable by Mott MacDonald, Inc., SAMTD's contracted project management firm.
