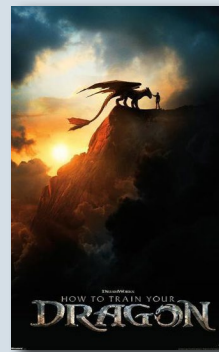

In-person registration is accepted at the Customer Service Center, 440 Church Street SE, 5th floor of the Parkway Building.

Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Early registration is encouraged, and registration is finalized once fees are paid in full.

## Fee Waivers

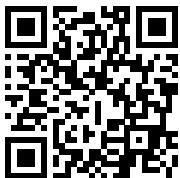
Fee waivers may be available for qualified Salem residents living within Salem city limits. Proof of the OR Health Plan, OR Trail Card, or WIC information is required. Eligibility is verified annually.

Addresses can be checked over the phone by calling 503-588-6261, choose option 5.

The first time you register for the year, you will need to register in-person at the Customer Service Center and provide your OHP, OTC, or WIC information.

To register online for the rest of the year, during office hours, put camps or classes in your account cart, and call the Customer Service Center to apply the fee waiver. Call 503-588-7272 option 7.


If your address is outside of Salem city limits and you are ineligible for a fee waiver, you can still register for programs.

## Cancellations/Refunds

The City of Salem reserves the right to cancel programs when minimum enrollment is not met. Full refunds will be issued when programs are canceled.

Registration fees may be transferred in full to another program of equal value if requested more than 10 business days in advance of program start.

### Refunds requested:

- **More than 10 business days in advance** are eligible for a 100% refund
- **Less than 10 business days in advance** are eligible for a 50% refund
- **On the day the program begins** are eligible for a 25% refund
- Refunds will not be granted after the first day of program, for absence, inclement weather/air quality, once a program has begun, or for amounts equal to or less than \$15 per person.

Refunds may take 4-6 weeks to receive.

## Basketball & Soccer Camps (Ages 5-10)

Work on the fundamentals of each sport, such as shooting, ball control, dribbling, passing, and scrimmage each day. Soccer participants need to wear shinguards. *Bring a bottle of water and a ball, if you have one, with the participant's name on it.*

## Flag Football Skills & Scrimmage

(Ages 8-12)

Work on basic skills and end each day with a scrimmage. Mouthpieces are recommended. Metal spikes are not allowed. *Wear tennis shoes, soccer or football cleats. Bring a bottle of water.*

## Futsal & Pickleball Camps (Ages 8-12)

Spend the week learning the rules and playing the sport. We provide the equipment. *Wear non-marking court shoes and bring a bottle of water. Bring a pickleball paddle, if you have one.*

## Tennis Camps (Ages 5-17)

For beginning and intermediate players, we use level appropriate balls and court sizes. Each level works on basic tennis strokes, player coordination, and match play. *Wear non-marking court shoes, bring a bottle of water and a tennis racquet, if you have one.*

## Tennis Match Play (Ages 11-17)

Sign up to play a singles or doubles match, each week for 4 weeks. Rec staff watch over the matches and assist as needed. *Wear non-marking court shoes, bring a bottle of water and a racquet.*

## Adult Pickleball Beginning-Advanced

Learn how to play, become familiar with the rules, and play weekly round-robin games. We provide balls and paddles. *Wear non-marking court shoes, bring a bottle of water and a paddle, if you have one.*

## Junior Ranger Camp (Ages 9-12)

Explore nature and learn how to protect our parks and natural areas, go on guided hikes with Ranger Mike and participate in activities to inspire a lifetime of environmental awareness and stewardship. *Wear clothes and shoes for walking and being outdoors all day. Sunscreen and bug spray must be able to be self-applied. Bring a lunch, snacks, and bottle of water.*

## Summer Parks Program (Ages 5-12)

The weekly camp offers 4-hours a day of screen-free time. Games, crafts, and free time are planned around the theme of the week. *Wear clothes for getting dirty and being active. Sunscreen must be able to be self-applied. Bring a lunch, a snack, bottle of water, and sunscreen.*

1-Day Drop In is a flexible option with limited openings at each park. Registration cuts off at midnight the night before. Bring proof of registration to check-in (electronic receipt or hard copy.) \$16 per person per day.

## Chess Wizards (Ages 5-12) **NEW**

All necessary materials provided, and camp includes a T-shirt, workbook, and folder. *Participants should bring a snack and a bottle of water.*

Join Chess Wizards for challenging chess lessons, exciting games, and prizes. Participants will improve their chess skills and give their most powerful muscle (their brain) a good work out! The week includes team chess games (like Corner Chess), tournaments, and puzzles.



## Coyle Outside Nature Camps

*Participants need to dress appropriately for spending the day outdoors, for getting feet wet, and clothes dirty. Sunscreen and bug spray must be able to be self-applied. Bring a lunch, snacks, and a bottle of water.*

### Fish, Forage, Fire! (Ages 8-13)

Learn the art of being a true outdoorsman! Activities focus on learning and developing food acquisition skills through fishing, archery, and foraging.

### Intro to Wilderness Survival (Ages 6-9)

Learn the basics of thriving in the wild! Skills taught/practiced may include shelters, wilderness medicine, teamwork, traps, orienteering, cordage.

### Intermediate Wilderness Survival

(Ages 8-11)

Fill the day building survival skills and testing real-life survival scenarios. Build initiative and self-control while learning skills such as tracking, knife safety, shelter building, and more.

### Advanced Survival (Ages 10-14)

This camp goes in depth into critical survival skills and scenarios that are both challenging and fun. Participants work on their own and in teams to solve problems and play survival themed games.
